Only a short drive from the bustle of Birmingham, Montgomery and Atlanta, Harbor Lodge at Children's Harbor on Lake Martin is an island of tranquility, where the sounds of traffic are replaced by the murmur of the wind in the pines and the lap of water on the shore.



From the design and color scheme of the 11 rustic cabins to their placement on 16 wooded acres on the shores of Lake Martin, Harbor Lodge creates a tranquil connection with nature.

Each cabin has four bedrooms, each sleeping up to five people. The broad porches that stretch along each cabin afford an unhurried opportunity for networking and community building. All areas, including the bathrooms, are wheelchair accessible.



A duplex cabin for use by staff or visiting speakers offers privacy yet is within a few steps of the conference center and guest cabins. Both apartments in this cabin have cable television, microwave, mini-fridge and breakfast area.

With its canopy entrance and covered walking overlooking Lake Martin, the conference center includes a registration office, a large room that can accommodate 250 people for meeting or eating, two breakout rooms that hold 50 people each, and a large commercial kitchen.



All of the meeting rooms feature state of the art audio/visual equipment, including large, flat panel monitors, and wireless internet access.

Sheltered by towering pines, an amphitheater is just the ticket for group activities in a natural setting.



Lake Martin is at the heart of outdoor activities at Harbor Lodge. Canoeing, swimming, playing on the Aqua Jump or the more leisurely pursuit of simply strolling along the beach are some of the options.

Traditional camp activities such as volleyball, basketball and horseshoes are a good way to unwind. In addition, a ropes course is often used in team building exercises.
